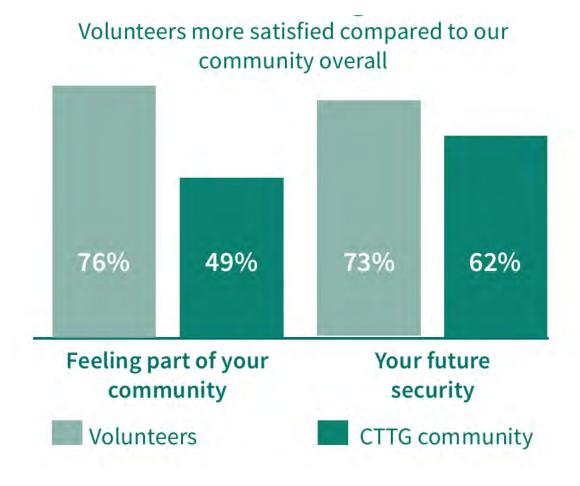
Australian Wellbeing score (2020)\*

#### We're not just a shed, we're a 'Shed plus'!

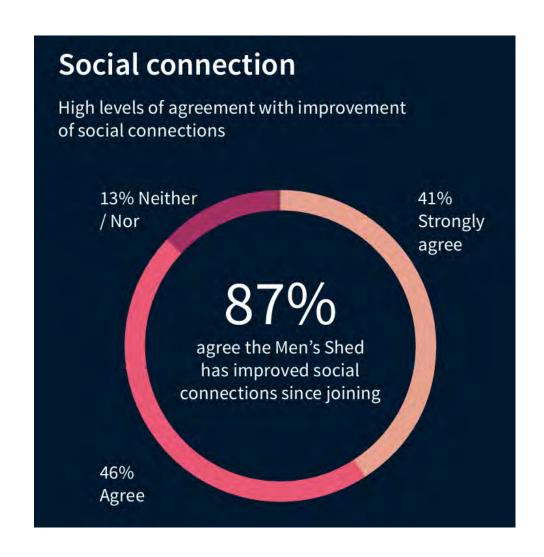
