# Round 8 Heavy Vehicle Safety Initiative (HVSI)



Round 8 of crucial project funding through the NHVR's Heavy Vehicle Safety Initiative (HVSI) has now closed

The Australian Government provided approximately \$4 million towards Round 8 of the HVSI, to support tangible, implementable industry-led heavy vehicle safety projects that address an existing issue for the transport and logistics sector and all road users.

# **BA-triples approved for use in South Australia**

The NHVR and DIT have approved a new configuration – the BA-triple – for use on the road train network on state-controlled roads in South Australia.

BA-triples are now an eligible combination under the National Class 2 Road Train Authorisation Notice

2022 (No.3) (in South Australia only) and the South Australian Class 3 Road Friendly Suspension Mass Exemption Notice 2022 (No.2).

The National Class 2 Road Train Authorisation Notice 2022 (No.3) provides access to complying road trains in New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia and Victoria.



### Training modules

The NHVR has developed 3 eLearning modules to assist local government in their role as road managers. Please allow 30-45 minutes to complete each module.



#### Introduction to heavy vehicles

This e-learning module provides comprehensive information to road managers about different types of vehicles, coupling types, mass limits, the Performance Based Standards scheme, access objectives and management, vehicle standards, the Australian Design Rules, and the NHVR's compliance and enforcement activities.



#### Guidelines for granting access

This e-learning module provides guidance and clarity on the <u>Approved Guidelines for Granting Access</u>. The guidelines provide information on aspects of heavy vehicle access decision making, under the HVNL. The NHVR, road authorities and road managers must have regard to these guidelines when making access decisions.



### **Network Access Policy**



- Revocation of the South Australia Class 1 Agricultural Vehicle Mass and Dimension Exemption Notice 2019
- National Class 1 Agricultural Vehicle and Combination Mass and Dimension Exemption Notice 2020 provided:
  - National consistent mass limits greater than those provided under the SA state notice
  - Night travel meets or exceeds authorisations provided under the SA notice and associated night travel bulletins
  - The terms "major and minor roads" removed
